

Lindsay Oswald Crawford was born 21st June 1891.

He began as a teaching assistant at Norwich Road Academy in 1910 at the age of 19.

Mr. Crawford became a certified teacher in Dec 1913.

AFFECTIONATE MEMORY of MEMORY LINDSAY. O. CRAWFORD. (AGED 27 years) who was killed during the great advance of the British Expeditionary Force in FRANCE, September, 22nd 1918. M^e Crawford was an excellent Teacher, who by his careful and painstaking work, earned the approval of all.

He was highly respected by his fellow teachers, and greatly beloved by his pupils.

The Managers, Teachers, and Scholars deeply regret his death. Mr. Crawford was called up for interview for the Army in September 1914. His last day of teaching was Ist October 1914.

Mr. Crawford was sadly killed in action during the First World War on 22⁻⁻ September 1918 at the age of 27years old.

Mr. Crawford has no known grave however is remembered on the Thetford War memorial and at St Peter's Church, Thetford. He is also listed on a memorial plaque at County Hall in Norwich for Norfolk teachers who died in the First World War.
