Curriculum Focus

English

This half term we are reading *The Way Home For Wolf* by Rachel Bright. We will be reading the book together as a class throughout this half term. We will be writing our own story based on the book building on our sentence level work from Year 1.



Maths

We will be developing our place value skills. We will work on our counting skills and learn how to write numbers from 0—100.

We will develop our problem solving and reasoning skills by answering more complex questions.



Science

We are learning about the human body. We will be focussing on the skeleton, keeping healthy and the major organs. The children will learn what animals and the human body need to survive and how we can look after our bodies.



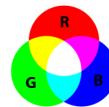
Phonics

We will be reviewing our phase 5 phonics over the next 5 weeks, then we will be using *Little Wandle's Bridge to Spelling*. We will also be working on our grammar and punctuation.



Art

Our topic in art this half term is colour and shape. We will be building on our knowledge of primary colours. We will be looking at the work of the artist Paul Klee and developing our own pieces of work based on his artistic style.



Life Skills

We will be learning that families are composed of different people who offer us care and support. We will be learning how other people show their feelings and how to respond to them. We will also look at manners and how to develop an understanding of self-respect.

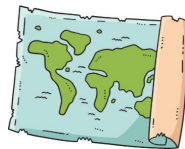
PE
