

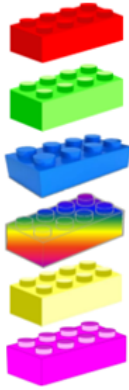

Norwich Road Academy School Values



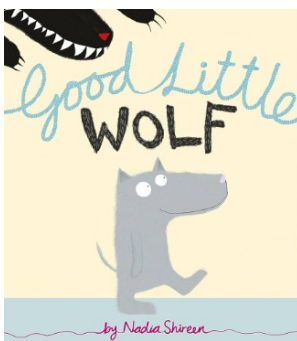
Welcome to Year 1 and Year 2!
