Yr 3 Trip to Kentwell Hall on 26th June 2024

In the Summer term our history topic will be 'The Tudors'. To bring this topic to life and enrich the curriculum, we will be taking the children to Kentwell Hall, in Suffolk, to experience a 'Tudor History Living Day'. This is an authentic re-creation of life in the Tudor era and a wonderful experience for the children to enjoy. You can find out more information here: www.kentwell.co.uk/schools

A visit to Kentwell Hall re-creation offers a fantastic opportunity for children to totally immerse themselves in the sights, sounds and smells of the past. Once we have entered the event all contact with the 21st century will cease. As far as the eye can see will be people from history, going about their daily business on the manor.

To make the experience as authentic as possible, children will need to **dress as a child from Tudor times**. Being in costume is a crucial part of getting into character and is a really enjoyable and memorable part of the visit for children.

Kentwell offers guidance on how to make simple Tudor costumes, adapting them from clothes you already have. Ideas will be posted on ClassDojo soon.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 26th June. We will be leaving school at 8.45am and will return at 3pm. Children should wear a traditional Tudor outfit. They will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle. A picnic area is provided.

The cost of the trip will be **£41.00**. This includes the coach, entrance to Kentwell Hall and all activities. Due to the cost of the trip and to support your child to attend, we are offering the opportunity to pay in 2 instalments.

The first instalment of £20.00 is due to be paid by 1st May 2024

The second and final instalment of £21.00 is due to be paid by 1st June 2024

It is not compulsory for you to pay for this event, however, we are only able to provide such opportunities for learning by obtaining contributions from parents and carers. Although regrettable, the decision to cancel this trip may be necessary if we do not receive sufficient donations to cover the cost of the expenditure of the trip.

Should you choose to withdraw your child from this trip, then any payments that you have made cannot be refunded.
