Year 3 Trip - Friday 10th May - The Botanic Garden - Cambridge University

Our Year 3 pupils have been given a wonderful opportunity to visit the Botanic Gardens at Cambridge University as an introduction to their Science topic – Cycles in Nature. The amazing thing is that the trip is funded by the Gardens, and therefore is free!

The trip will take place on Friday 10th May 2024, during the school day. Children will leave Norwich Road soon after registration to arrive in Cambridge by 10am. We have a number of workshops linked to plant classification. These include classifying plants, using simple identification keys and a tour of different plants to make careful observations.

We are due to leave Cambridge at 2.00 pm, so hope to be **back at school between 3.15pm and 3.30pm** – depending on traffic. If we are held up, we will let you know via Class Dojo.

Children will need to come to school **in school uniform** but should wear a waterproof coat as much of the time will be spent outside.

Pupils should bring a packed lunch and a drink of water with them. If your child is entitled to funded school meals, a packed lunch will still be available to take from the school kitchen and you will be asked closer to the trip date whether this is required.
