Do not share images or videos of the live lesson. It is very important to respect the privacy of everyone attending.



Parents or carers will need to appear briefly on the screen at the start of the lesson to confirm they give consent for their child to participate in the live lesson.

It is always advisable for parents to supervise their child's internet use and online learning – check what their children have been asked to do and the websites they need to access.

Learners, please mute your microphone when you are not talking.
