This half term the children will be focusing on our Code of Conduct including: 'SMART' Walking 'SLANT' Listening Our Smart Uniform

Politeness and manners, these are 'SPENT': 'Smile, Please, Excuse me, use a Name, Thank you'. We encourage children to demonstrate this behaviour and use these words.



Curriculum Focus

English

English is delivered through Talk for Writing. Each half term we will use a book as our 'model text' and the children will learn a shortened version of the book. We create a story map and use actions to support our retelling as well as exploring the story through drama and other activities. As a class we will then 'innovate' the text and create an adapted version of the story. This half term our text is based on 'Owl Babies'.

Maths

This half term our maths is all about counting to 5, using number rhymes and nursery rhyme to support this learning. We will also be comparing sizes such as big and small, and using positional language in our play. We will build obstacle courses to support our language ; over, under, through, behind and in front.



Phonics

Children will be taught Phonics during carpet sessions, following our Phonics scheme, Little Wandle. This half term we will focus on settling the children into nursery, sitting on the carpet and tuning into listening. We will also be singing rhymes and playing rhyming games. Each half term we will focus on 3 Nursery rhymes. This half term is 'Old McDonald', 'Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes' and 'If you're happy and you know it'.

Life Skills

This half term our focus is on 'self regulation'. We will be learning how to take turns and share the resources with others in the class. The children will begin to make relationships with members of staff and know who they can speak to if they have a concern or need support to share and turn take. We will also be learning to play alongside others in class and how to communicate with



Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Our topic this half term is 'All About Me'. We will be talking about ourselves and our families and developing a sense of chronology using past, present and future.

We will be thinking about where we live and the location of our school in the local area as well as the different jobs in our community.

We will go on an autumn walk around school and use our senses to identify the changes in our environment.
